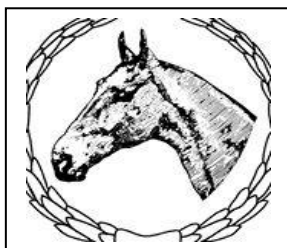
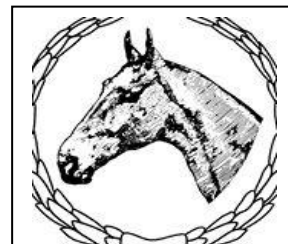

<b>9.00am</b>	
<b>Class 1</b>	Broodmare, 4 years old and over, with foal at foot or Certificate of Service for 2014 (Copy of Certificate of Service to be included with entry) <b>(Foal has to be at least 4 weeks of age on date of show)</b>
<b>Class 2</b>	Foal likely to make a Hunter <b>(Foal has to be 4 weeks old or over on date of show).</b>
<b>Class 3</b>	Yearling Filly, Yearling Colt likely to make a Hunter
<b>Class 4</b>	Two/Three year old filly or gelding likely to make a Hunter
<b>Class 5</b>	Hunter, Mare or Gelding over 158cm (15.2hh)
<b>Class 6</b>	Small Hunter, Mare or Gelding over 148cm (14.2hh), not exceeding 158cm (15.2hh)
	<b>Please note that classes 5 and 6 will not start before 10.00am</b>
<b>RING 1</b>	<b>RIDDEN CLASSES</b>
<b>Class 7</b>	Riding Horse 158cm (14.2hh) and over <b>(Horse must either be Hunter OR Riding Horse – and cannot compete in both sections.)</b>
<b>Class 8</b>	Race Horse to Riding Horse <b>Horses must be full thoroughbred, registered with Weatherbys, must have been in training as a racehorse, must be over 4 years old must be over 15.0hh Copies of Weatherby's Registration and Training Certificate to be included with entry.</b>
<b>Class 9</b>	Show Cob exceeding 148cm (14.2hh) Must be shown trimmed and hogged
<b>Class 10</b>	Traditional Native Cob exceeding 148cm (14.2hh)
<b>Class 11</b>	Coloured Horse or Pony, 4 years and over, not to exceed 148cm (14.2hh). Leading rein not permitted.
<b>Class 12</b>	Coloured Horse or Pony, 4 years and over, exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). Leading rein not permitted.
<b>Class 13</b>	Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). Rider to be 16 years or under on 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2014.
<b>Class 14</b>	Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh). Rider to be 10 years or under on 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2014. Pony to be shown in snaffle bridle <b>Children may not compete on the same pony in Classes 14 and 15</b>
<b>Class 15</b>	Lead Rein Pony not exceeding 122cm (12.0hh). Rider to be 8 years or under on 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2014. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle <b>Children may not compete on the same pony in Classes 14 and 15</b>

<b>Class 16</b>	Yearling/Two/Three year old filly or gelding not to exceed 148cm (14.2hh) at maturity
<b>Class 17</b>	Yearling/Two/Three year old filly or gelding exceeding 148cm (14.2hh) at maturity
<b>Class 18</b>	Arab, Anglo Arab or Part Bred Arab. Any age in hand.
<b>Class 19</b>	Coloured Pony not to exceed 148cm (14.2hh). Any age in hand.
<b>Class 20</b>	Coloured Horse exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). Any age in hand.
<b>RING 2</b>	<b>VETERANS</b>
<b>Class 21</b>	Veteran Horse or Pony. 25 years and over. To be shown under saddle. Veteran Horse or Pony. 20 – 24 years. To be shown under saddle. Pre Veteran Horse or Pony. 15 – 19 years. To be shown under saddle. Please state age of horse/pony on entry form.
<b>Class 22</b>	Veteran Horse or Pony. 25 years and over. To be shown in hand. Veteran Horse or Pony. 20 – 24 years. To be shown in hand. Pre Veteran Horse or Pony. 15 – 19 years. To be shown in hand. Please state age of horse/pony on entry form.
	<p><b>Veteran Horse Society Scottish Veteran Horse of the Year 2014 Qualifier</b> The Veteran Horse Society Scottish Showing Series is kindly sponsored by Allen &amp; Page Quality Horse Feeds. Qualifiers are open to both Members &amp; Non Members of the Veteran Horse Society. Please note all competitors should acquaint themselves with the rules of the VHS, they can be found at <a href="http://www.veteran-horse-society.co.uk">www.veteran-horse-society.co.uk</a>. The Champion and Reserve Champion Veteran will go forward to the Supreme Final in September 2014. All competitors must be VHS Members to gain the qualifying card.</p> <p><b><u>Veteran Rules:-</u></b> No galloping or spurs allowed in the ring. Basic walk, trot and canter. Mark system is in relation to condition and movement in relation to age. Handler or rider must be 16 years of age or over. Turnout in accordance with breed. All competitors must be compliant with Veteran Horse Society Rules and Regulations. Qualification cards will be handed out in the ring at the time of presentation of rosettes. The same veteran and handler/rider combination must carry the qualification. No exchange of horse or rider is accepted. The Champion and Reserve Champion will go on to compete at the Veteran Horse Society Scottish Veteran Horse of the year 2014. Second Reserve on standby.</p>

<b>Class 24</b>	First Ridden Pony, Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor. <b>Pony and Rider combination not to enter any other show class.</b>
<b>Class 25</b>	Open Ridden Pony, Welsh C & D,
<b>Class 26</b>	Open Ridden Pony, Fell, Highland, Connemara, New Forest, Dales
<b>Class 27</b>	Open Ridden Pony, Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor. <b>Ponies may not be shown by same child in Classes 23 and 27.</b>

<b>Class 28</b>	In-Hand Pony, Any age, Welsh C & D, Dales, Fell, Highland, Connemara, New Forest
<b>Class 29</b>	In-Hand Pony, Any age, Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor. <b>Special rosette to highest placed yearling in classes 28 and 29</b>
<b>RING 3</b>	<b>REGISTERED SHETLANDS</b>
<b>Class 30</b>	Lead Rein – Rider to be 8 years old or under
<b>Class 31</b>	Open Ridden – Rider can be any age.
<b>Class 32</b>	Shetland, 4 years old and over, In-Hand
<b>Class 33</b>	Shetland, 3 years old and under, In-Hand
<b>Class 34</b>	Broodmare, 4 years old and over, with foal at foot or Certificate of Service for 2014 (Copy of Certificate of Service to be included with entry). Standard or Miniature Shetland. <b>Foal has to be at least 4 weeks old or over on date of show.</b>
<b>Class 35</b>	Foal, Shetland. <b>Foal has to be at least 4 weeks old or over on date of show.</b>

<b>RING 3</b>	<b>CLYDESDALES</b>
<b>Class 36</b>	Mare with foal at foot, Foal, Yearling/two year old filly or gelding. <b>Foal has to be at least 4 weeks old or over on date of show.</b>
<b>Class 37</b>	Yeld Mare, 3 years old or over
<b>Class 38</b>	Gelding, 3 years old or over

<b>9.30am</b>	<b>WORKING HUNTER PONIES</b>
	<b>Animals may only be shown in one Working Hunter class</b> <b>Classes may be amalgamated if insufficient entries.</b>
<b>Class 39</b>	Mountain & Moorland. Registered. Ponies not to exceed 122cms (12.0hh) The maximum height of fences will be 61cm (2'0")
<b>Class 40</b>	Mountain & Moorland. Registered. Ponies to exceed 122cms (12.0hh) but not to exceed 138cms (13.2hh). The maximum height of fences will be (70cm)(2'3½")
<b>Class 41</b>	Mountain & Moorland. Registered. Ponies exceeding 138cms (13.2hh). The maximum height of fences will be 85cm (2'9")
<b>Class 42</b>	<b>Clear Round Genuine Beginner Working Hunter Pony</b> Clear Round Rosettes will be awarded The maximum height of fences will be 45cm (1'6") <b>NOTE: there will be no show section in class 42</b> <b>Pony NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter class</b>
<b>Class 43</b>	Working Hunter Pony Not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh) The maximum height of fences will be 66cm (2'2") <b>Pony NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter class</b>
<b>Class 44</b>	Working Hunter Pony Over 128cm (12.2hh) but not exceeding 138cm (13.2hh) The maximum height of fences will be 76cm (2'6") <b>Pony NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter class</b>
<b>Class 45</b>	Working Hunter Pony Over 138cm (13.2hh) but not exceeding 148cm (14.2hh) The maximum height of fences will be 90cm (3') <b>Pony NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter class</b>

<b>Class 46</b>	<b>Clear Round Genuine Beginner Working Hunter Horse</b> Clear Round Rosettes will be awarded The maximum height of fences will be 61cm (2') <b>NOTE: there will be no show section in class 46</b> <b>Horse NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter class</b>
<b>Class 47</b>	Novice over 148cm(over 14.2hh). Not having won 1st/2nd/3rd in Novice WH or above The maximum height of fences will be 80cm (2'7")

<b>Class 48</b>	Intermediate over 148cm(over 14.2hh) The maximum height of fences will be 85cm (2'9") <b>Horse NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter Class</b>
<b>Class 49</b>	Open over 148cm(over 14.2hh) The maximum height of fences will be 90cm (3'0") <b>Horse NOT to be shown in any other Working Hunter Class</b>
<b>RING 5</b>	<b>SENIOR SHOWJUMPING</b>
<b>10.00am</b>	Entries accepted on the field - £10.00 per class, (£8.00 if entered before the day). Competitors in the showjumping will be limited to two classes
<b>Class 50</b>	Novice. Max height 70cm in first round. <b>Not having won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in Novice Showjumping or above</b>
<b>Class 51</b>	Intermediate. Max height 80cm in first round. <b>Not having won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in Open Showjumping</b>
<b>Class 52</b>	Small Open. Max height 90cm in first round.
<b>Class 53</b>	Open. Max height 1.05m in first round.
<b>Class 54</b>	Genuine Wibbly Wobbly Beginners – cross poles only
<b>RING 5</b>	<b>JUNIOR SHOWJUMPING (15 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014)</b>
<b>Class 55</b>	Genuine Wibbly Wobbly (can be assisted round course), cross poles only <b>Note:</b> No lead reins permitted. <b>A RIDER MAY NOT ENTER BOTH CLASSES 54 AND 55 or any other jumping class.</b>
<b>Class 56</b>	Cradle Stakes. Jumping for ponies 148cm (14.2hh) or under. Rider to be 12 yrs or under on 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2014. Max height 55cm. Combination never having won a showjumping class. <b>Note:</b> No lead reins permitted <b>A RIDER MAY NOT ENTER BOTH CLASSES 54 AND 55</b>
<b>Class 57</b>	Novice. Max height 65cm in first round. <b>Not having won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in Novice Showjumping or above</b>
<b>Class 58</b>	Intermediate. Max height 75cm in first round.
<b>Class 59</b>	Open. Max height 85cm in first round.

- **All ridden and driven horses and ponies to be four years old and over.**
- **NO STALLIONS ALLOWED: only yearling colts.**
- **Broodmares without a foal at foot must nominate the stallion visited on entry form.**
- **All foals must be led.**
- **All foals must be 4 weeks old or over on date of show.**
- **Any lost horse shoes must be reported to the Secretary as soon as possible.**
- **Everyone mounted, whether competing or not, must wear protective headgear conforming to current British Standards.**
- **Mountain and Moorland entries must be shown unplaited.**
- **Trophies to be returned by trophy winners by 1<sup>st</sup> May 2015.**

◆ ***CLASSES MAY CLASH AND WILL NOT BE HELD UP***

- ◆ **Objections to be lodged with the Secretary within half an hour of class at cost of £50.00.**
- ◆ **If insufficient entries in any class, the Committee reserve the right to amalgamate the class, or cancel the class when entry money will be refunded.**
